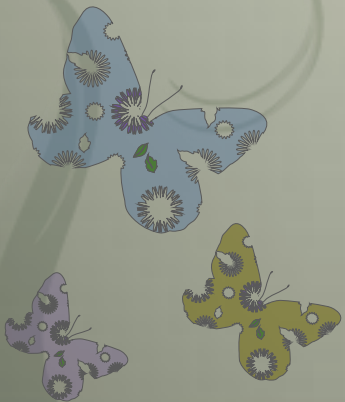

INTRODUCTION

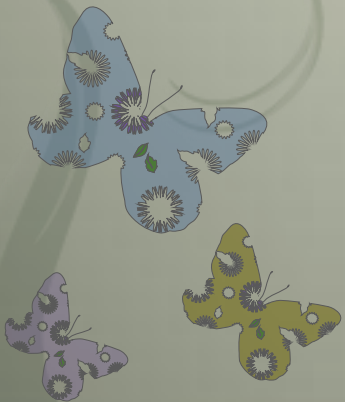
- ✿ Many believers want "fire-breathing preachers" to ignite the flame within them but failed to realize that they are the church and perhaps the problem is within them.

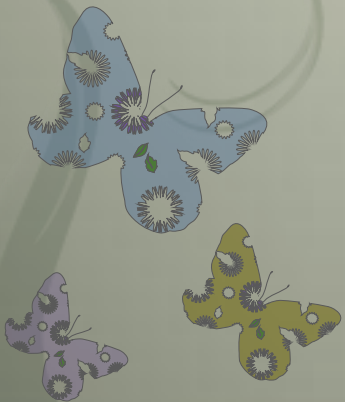
- ✿ God's Command:

God commanded Moses to give Aaron and his sons to keep the fire burning in the burnt offering altar. In order to keep it burning it needs two elements: *log* and *fire*.



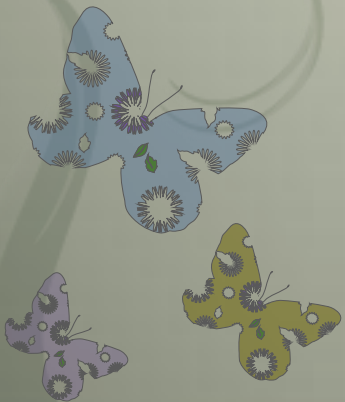
INTRODUCTION

- ✿ Every believer should have elements wherever they go. The two required elements is the *Holy Spirit* and *Fire*



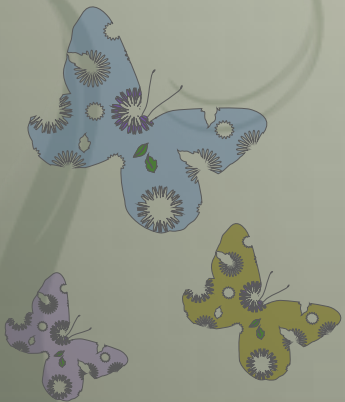
INTRODUCTION

- ✿ *Fire* represents the presence and power of God (Moses' burning bush experience).



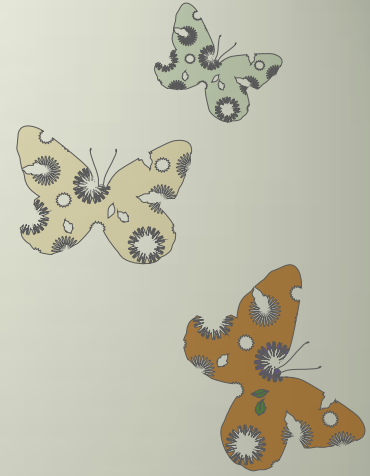
The two elements

- Definition of Fire:

1. The active form of burning characterized by heat and light of combustion;

2. Strong feeling and excitement;

3. To become excited and aroused.

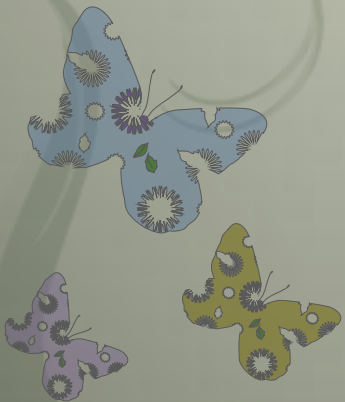


The two elements

- ✿ The purpose of Fire:

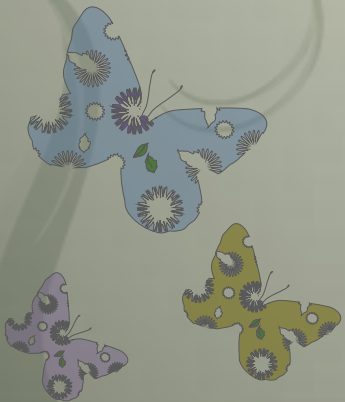
1. Commonly used to heat things up, mainly food, it kills germs.

2. In a spiritual perspective, the Holy Spirit fire burns up the impurities to purify and sanctify the believer, It kills the *germ* of sin.



Leviticus 6

- ✿ V.11- As the priest is to remove the ashes that hinder the fire, we too are to get rid of the ashes of sin in our lives to keep the fire burning in our hearts.
- ✿ V.12- As the priest is to put another log on the fire, to keep it burning, we must fuel our life with the Word of God and prayer.
- ✿ V.13- The fire should never go out. We need to keep the fire burning to excite us preach the Gospel to the lost and the dying.
